Listed are a few pointers to help us start...

- ❖ The Library on the C Floor is the room assigned for Night Study.
- Students must be in their seats for 7:00pm, ready for study. Students are expected to attend on time. A toilet break should be taken before the commencement of Night Study.
- Attendance Rolls are **called** in order to record attendance and a seating plan is in place.
- Student Journals are stamped by The Night Study Supervisor(s) to show and monitor attendance.
- ❖ At all times the total number of students present must **match** the number of students **marked in**.
- Only student names printed on the roll can **ATTEND** Night Study, as they are enrolled for it.
- * All DLS school rules extend into NIGHT Study, Our *Code of Behaviour* is available on request from The College Office.
- Students are not permitted to use their phones, laptops may be used where a school has a NO BOOK policy this is agreed prior to starting Night Study.

Students should Study in silence and refrain from disrupting others.

- 1. Students are expected to bring all books/texts/materials to study and to avoid borrowing or moving around to get books from other students.
- 2. A student should only leave the study centre in an exceptional circumstance and must ask permission of the supervisor to do so.

Silence is imperative for the study environment; disruptive behaviour will not be tolerated.

- 3. Students' who wish to leave Night Study early, must present a note, with written parental permission (A Text is NOT acceptable), to the supervisor. Another option is to email Mrs. E O'Connor to give advance notice. Permission to leave will be given by The Supervisor. A record is then written into <u>The NS Incident Report Book</u>. This is dated and is 'initialled off' by The Supervisor on duty.
- 4. Incidents that occur during study are recorded in *The NS Incident Report Book* by The Supervisor on duty.
- 5. Students must remain in the seat assigned to them, this is in the interest of safety. A seating plan will be in operation. Students must sanitise and leave the centre clean and tidy.
- 6. *The Library* will be checked by the nightly Supervisor before and after each session to monitor damage; Wilful damage to school property will have to be paid for and a removal from Night Study may be exercised.
- 7. In the unlikely event of extreme weather conditions or other exceptional circumstances, every effort will be made to give notice if Night Study has to be cancelled. A text alert will be sent (always check website).
- 8. Another centre(s) will be opened when numbers exceed those allowed in the primary centre, The Senior Library/Study Hall.

Contact may be made with home to verify any absences. Students who persistently breach rules will not be permitted to attend Night Study.
